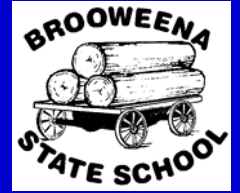

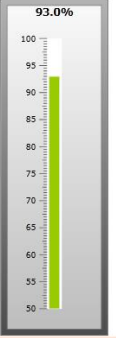

See you in Term 4.

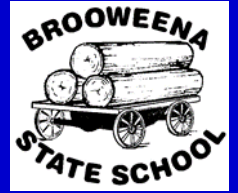

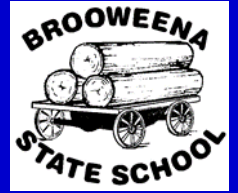

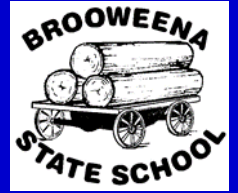
Thank you for reading my letter, I hope you have a great rest of the year. Good luck in high school.
