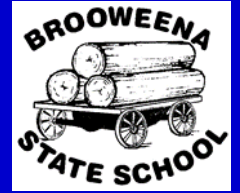

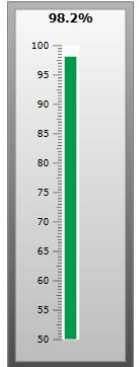

DAILY RAPID READING

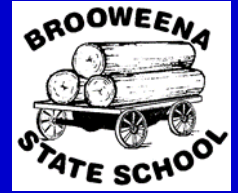

10 50am: Group time-story, singing

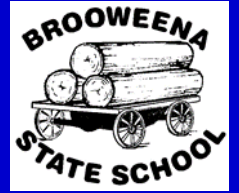
