Each term, I attend English assessment moderation meetings with the other small schools in our cluster. At these meetings, a teacher group assesses samples of students' assessment tasks. Together, the group consider the task specific standard descriptions on a Guide to Making Judgement to make an on-balance decision about the overall quality that best matches the student response and award an overall grade, using the five point A-E scale. The quality of work that our students at Brooweena have produced has been amazing. All of our students have achieved well in term 1. Well done!

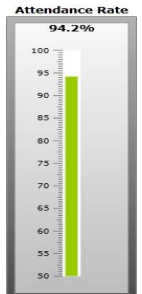
I'd like to say thank you to everyone that donated Coles Sports Vouchers. We sent away four large satchels full to the brim to be counted.

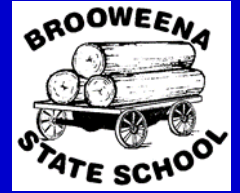

Peter Parker put on his spider man costume that has white eyes, ^{his} red and blue with black lines. ^{It has a} big spider on the back and a small spider on the front, then

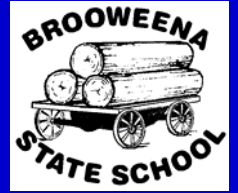
