## This funding will be used to

- Improve the writing achievement of **all** students in all key learning areas
- Enhance teacher knowledge of Australian Curriculum writing through deepening knowledge of achievement standards and curriculum intent
- 75% of students achieving A – C in writing

## Our initiatives include

- Engage regional expertise to improve teacher ability to identify the writing demands of the Australian Curriculum learning and subjects in C2C units of work.
- 100% students with disability with enacted Individual Curriculum Plans.
- Provide focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year-level achievement standards
- Develop a plan for monitoring early phase literacy, including the schedule of Early Start assessments, opportunities for professional conversations regarding student progress and strategies for intervention
- Provide opportunities for staff to engage in regional moderation across schools.
- Provide opportunity for parents to engage with writing pedagogy through identified whole school events.
